If you know you'd like to have a team, you just need to do the following:

Once you are on the above website, scroll down to the document that looks like this:



* Instructions for Captains explaining how to put your team online, create your team number, and register yourself on the captain's-only team (including Captains-Only Team Numbers)

That will give you information on how to put your team online and register yourself as captain. Make sure you don't register yourself directly onto your team you create. As captain, you should only pay \$3 when you register, but you must use the correct team number provided in this document. If you mistakenly do not use the captain's ID number and register directly on your team, you will not receive a refund.

Next, click on this document that looks like this:



* Team Information Sheet

Fill out the team information sheet and fax it in asap.

Then, click on the Captain's Agreement form and that will give you a list of documents you need to read. Please make sure you click each link and read through the information. Send an e-mail to heidi.stryker3@gmail.com with any questions you have.
