



SELF-RATE APPEAL INFORMATION

The correct way to appeal a self rating is during the registration. When the player receives their rating, the system asked him/her to accept, pick a higher rating or appeal. If they clicks the appeal option, the system brings up the form, which they fill out, and then it gets forwarded to the SCTA. This is immediate. The player can then proceed to register on the team, (if the team rating permits,) or not.

If a player leaves that page then the only way to appeal is to complete the [Player Background History Form](#) and submit to via email lmilan@scta.usta.com or fax 310-824-7691.

NEW THIS YEAR - Players with expired ratings will not be allowed to self-rate at a lower level than their last published NTRP rating. However, they will have the opportunity to file a self-rate appeal.
