



WAYNE BRYAN'S TENNIS BIOG.

Bryan heads up *KIDS DAYS* for the ATP in America. He also does "on court interviews", intros, tennis clinics, television commentary, and other emcee work for the *Tour* and the *Outback Champion Series*. He is a frequent national clinician and speaker. He also makes numerous appearances each year as the front man for his two bands, *The Wayne Bryan Band* and *The Bryan Bros. Band*.

Bryan was the Coach of the *Idaho Sneakers* of World Team Tennis in 1999 and he coached the *Sacramento Capitals* to the *World Team Tennis Championship* in 2002 and the Western Division Championship in 2003 and 2004. He was named the WTT *Coach of the Year* in 2004, 2005, and 2006.

Bryan's twin sons, *Mike* and *Bob*, are currently the #1 ranking doubles team in the world and have won 38 doubles titles, including the *French Open* in 2003, the *US Open* in 2005, the 2006 & 2007 *Australian Open*, and the 2006 *Wimbledon Doubles Championships* - - - a *Career Grand Slam*. They have won eleven of their *Davis Cup* matches for the US against *Slovakia, Austria, Sweden, Belarus, Spain* twice, *Belgium, Romania, Chile, Russia, and the Czech Republic*. They were the #1 team in the world in 2003, 2005 & 2006, and they are currently the #1 team in the world.

In their two years at *Stanford*, their team won the *NCAA Championship* in 1997 and 1998. In their sophomore year Bob won a rare *NCAA "Triple Crown"* winning the *Singles Championship*, the *Doubles Championship* with *Mike*, and the *Team Title*. *Bob* was the "*College Player of the Year*" in '98.

In the juniors, the *Bryan twins* won 18 gold balls (for national championships). *Bob* was #1 in the nation his final year of the juniors, with *Mike* being #4. They were #1 in the U.S. in doubles in the 12s, 14s, and twice in the 18s. *Bob* was the "*US Junior Player of the Year*" in '96.

Bryan founded and ran the *Cabrillo Racquet Club*, with numerous nationally ranked players and youngsters being awarded Division I Tennis Scholarships. *Cabrillo* won 32 SoCal Junior Team Tennis Titles and 10 State JTT Championships during *Bryan's* 25 years at the club. *Cabrillo* was named the Southern California "*Club of the Year*" in 1995. *Bryan* was the #1 player and captain of his U.C. Santa Barbara Tennis Team in the late 60s.

Bryan speaks for *Wilson, adidas, WTT, the USTA, the USPTA and the USPTR*. His topics include: "*The Formula for Junior Tennis Success*"; "*Motivating Juniors*"; "*Making Tennis Fun!*"; "*Team Drills that are Fun and Get Results*"; "*Big Time Doubles Drills and Games*"; "*Champion Tennis Parenting*"; "*Making Your High School Team More Like a College Program*" and "*Tennis-Press Relations*".

Bryan is a dynamic speaker who can entertain, motivate, and educate. The SFX Agency coordinates *Bryan's* national speaking and clinics.

Bryan, along with award winning sports columnist *Woody Woodburn*, has a book entitled, *Raising Your Child to be a Champion, in Athletics, Arts, and Academics* and a video, *Drills and Games that are Fun and Get Results!*
